THUMP ... THUD , THUMP ... THUD!

When a potter bakes a pot, he checks its solidity by pulling it out of the oven and thumping it. If it "sings," it's ready. If it "thuds," it's placed back in the oven. The character of a person is also checked by thumping. Have you been thumped lately? Late night phone calls. Grouchy teacher, Grumpy moms. Burnt meals. Flat tires. You've –got-to-be-kidding deadlines. Those are thumps ~ irritating inconveniences that trigger the worst in us. How do we respond? Do we sing? Or do we thud? If you have a tendency to thud more than you sing, take heart. There is hope for us "thudders". Begin by thanking God for thumps (James 1:2). Every thump is a reminder that God is molding you (Hebrews 12:5-8). Learn from each thump. Look upon each inconvenience as an opportunity to develop patience and persistence.

Remember, no thump is disastrous. All thumps work for good if we are loving and obeying God.
